The PE Fire Protection exam is computer-based and administered one day per year.

They'll be given on a single-day this fall (October 22, 2020) at Pearson-Vue test centers. The exam is moving from an 8-hour, 80-question, multiple-choice only question style to an 8.5-hour, 85-question, varied question style exam.

The PE exam is slightly different for each type of engineering, but here is what you can expect for a PE exam in Fire Protection Engineering. The exam takes up to 8 hours. The exam consists of 80 multiple choice questions.

The PE Fire Protection exam is a computer-based test and lasts a total of 9.5 hours. The exam includes 85 questions total, covering multiple-choice and alternative item types. This exam is only offered once a year in October, and students are urged to register as soon as possible.

Professional Engineer applicants who are applying for a waiver of the Fundamentals of Engineering (FE) exam [also known as an Engineering-in-Training (EIT) waiver] need to submit a complete application package as described above.
