A common visual symptom of MS is optic neuritis \u2013 inflammation of the optic (vision) nerve. Optic neuritis usually occurs in one eye and may cause aching pain with eye movement, blurred vision, dim vision, or loss of color vision. For example, the color red may appear washed out or gray. Vision may be lost completely in the affected eye.
